Application Guidelines (Please read carefully)

Applicant must be:

1. A student enrolled in Badger, Big Foot, Williams Bay or Faith Christian high schools who will enroll in a two year or four year college to pursue course work toward a degree in a horticultural degree in a horticulture-related program. A horticulture-related program includes, but is not limited to, horticulture, environmental science, landscape architecture, botany and agronomy.

OR

2. A student enrolled in Badger, Big Foot, Williams Bay or Faith Christian high schools who will enroll in a two year or four year college to pursue course work toward a degree in a historical preservation-related program. A historical preservation-related program includes, but is not limited to, historic preservation, architectural history, building restoration or related programs.
